45+ Cactus Consolation, Mesa, AZ - Utah Red Sox 12, Las Vegas Stars 8

The Utah Red Sox scored early and often while securing the 45+ Consolation Championship over the Las Vegas Stars 12-8 at Fitch Park in Mesa, spring training home of the Oakland A's. The Sox' Gabe Aguana and Jared Bills combined to neutralize a potent Stars offense, led by the Stars' Drew Vertes who tallied four hits.

60+ Central, Mesa, AZ - DFW Phillies 11, Dragons 6

The DFW Phillies dug out of an early 5-0 hole to overcome the Dragons in the 60 Central Division championship at Hohokam Stadium. After allowing five runs in the first inning Phillies starting pitcher and team MVP Gregory Rodriguez took control allowing just one run over the final eight innings. Paul Drake led the Phillies offense going four for four with two runs scored and two doubles.

45+ Central, Tempe Diablo Stadium - Tri-Valley Giants 7, Chicago N TNP 2

Ferrando Naranjo tossed a complete game and gave up only two runs on five hits to lead Tri-Valley past Chicago, 7-2. Trailing 2-0, the Giants put together a three-run rally in the fourth inning and never looked back. Calvin Thomas was two-for-two with an RBI and a double to lead an 11-hit attack for the Giants.

60+ Cactus, Mesa, AZ - Colorado Stars 8, Chicago North Cubs 6

The Colorado Stars rode the back of Hal Friskey to the 60 Cactus championship with an 8-6 win over the Chicago North Cubs in a thriller at Riverview Fields. Friskey, the Tournament MVP, scattered nine hits for the complete game victory *AFTER* pitching five shutout innings to shut down the MS Warriors in the Semifinals. The Cubs never quit, scoring a run in the eighth to make it 8-6, and loaded the bases in the ninth after one out with a hit and two consecutive walks. Friskey steadied himself and the Stars defense came up with a game ending double play to end the game.
