MSBL World Series Spotlight Raleigh Braves - Dave Halley

David Halley...In his own words

I play and manage a team in the Central North Carolina MSBL and have been attending the World Series since about 2003, where I have developed a bunch of really great long-term friendships. Back in 2003 I was playing on a team that was in another baseball league in the Triangle Area that was floundering. At the time there was also a more organized MSBL league in our area too. Around 2003 most of the teams from that league decided to fold that league and join the Central North Carolina MSBL, which was run by Glen Garrison (MSBL HOF). I was frustrated with the other league and blurted out one day that I would manage the team if we moved to CNCMSBL. Careful what you ask for!

I also started going to the Fall Classic as a player with the 35+ Raleigh Red Sox around 2003. I played for the 35+ Red Sox for about four years and then started playing with the 45+ Raleigh Red Birds around 2007. In 2009, I started managing the 45+ Raleigh Braves in the Fall Classic. We struggled, rarely getting past the first game of playoffs. (continued on page 2)

Fantastic Weather Continues With Ideal Playing Conditions On Day Two!

One of the areas where the MSBL leads the way is with our special playing rules. Many of these rules are in place to help assist the team manager's with getting as many players into each game as possible, while still maintaining a competitive balance. These include the courtesy runner, the shared batter and the A/B batting position. Unlimited batting order (participation divisions must bat 14) along with free defensive substitutions, are designed to enhance the manager's in game strategy. These special rules are not in place to over turn the outcomes of games won and lost on the field. For example, if the wrong courtesy runner is running the bases, once time is called, replace that runner with the correct player. In the event the wrong A/B or shared batter is at bat, the result is a player batting out of turn. These are not protest able infractions. If a team wins the game, but realizes that the other team didn't bat the required number of batters, it's not protest able. The MSBL doesn't allow winning teams to protest their games in an attempt to reduce their runs allowed. And we don't recognize third party protest either! The only time a protest is warranted is to right a wrong, that resulted from one team gaining an unfair advantage over another team that might have assisted that team in winning the game. Teams that are lodging a protest during a game, need \$50 in order to do so. The money is returned if the protest is upheld.

In 2011, we went 0-5! That was the low point in Raleigh Braves history. Then I started listening, reading and watching what the successful managers were doing. With a new approach and strong recruiting, we won the 45+ Central Fall Classic going 8-0 in 2012. After 2012, the guys were looking for a change of scenery, so we started coming to the World Series in Arizona starting in 2013. We have also played in MSBL regional tournaments in Atlanta, Greenville, Richmond and Charlottesville. Here are some of our championships: 2012 45+ Central Division Fall Classic Champions, 2014 45+ Central Division World Series Champions, 2017 50+ Central Division World Series Champions, 2018 50+ Central Division World Series Champions. I also played with the Texas Redbirds, managed by Chris Hux, when we won the 45+ Puerto Rico Classic in 2016. So, I now have a ring from each of the three ring events the MSBL holds each year. I am a consulting forester and own and operate True North Forest Management Services, a private forestry consulting firm in North Carolina. (continued on page 3)
