- In his own words...

I became involved with my local MSBL back in 2005 and play my league ball in Ventura, California. It all started with a call to Steve Sigler about the potential for my team to play in MSBL tournaments and I haven't stopped yet. What is significant to me in continuing to play adult baseball is meeting lots of players and creating lots of friends over the past 27 years. My teams have won many local league championships, regional tournament championships, and two World Series championships. However, watching grown men jump around, shout, cry, and hug each other after winning a World Series championship is my favorite baseball moment of all time. I'll never forget the anxiety of playing in my first MSBL World Series tournament in 2005, which is right along there with winning our first World Series championship in 2011 at Tempe Diablo Stadium. MSBL baseball has added a ton more fun and dozens of friendships to my life. I have participated in baseball tournaments managed by five different organizations, and MSBL tournaments are superior to all the others.

Participation Division Requirements (minimum number of batters)

Teams must get at least 14 batters and at bat during a scheduled 9 inning game. Keep in mind that even if the game doesn't go the full 9 innings, each team is still responsible for making sure 14 players receive an at bat.

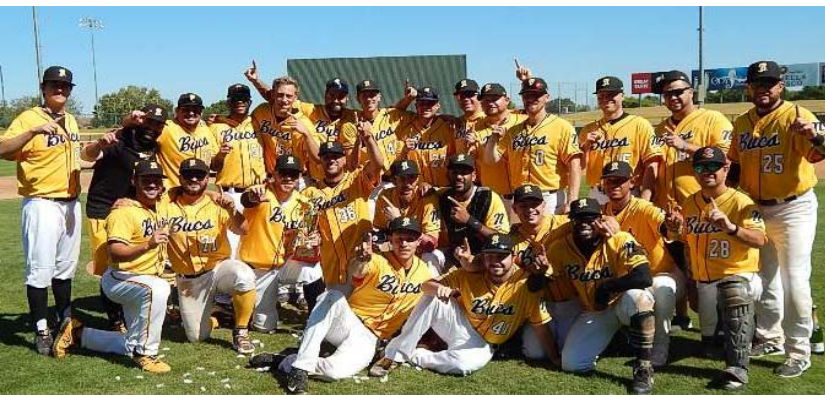

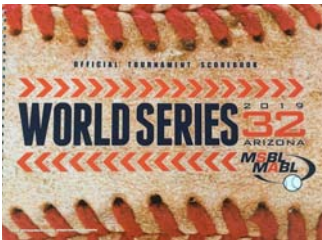

25+ Central: Denver Kokopeli's 16, LA Legends 8

Los Angeles jumped out 7-0 in the second inning, but Denver outscored the Legends 16-1 the rest of the way to walk off with the 25+ Central title. It was the first championship ring for the Kokopeli's in eleven trips to the MSBL World Series. The teams were even at eight runs apiece after five innings. Denver took the lead on a two-out, two-run double by Nate Cabrera in the sixth and never looked back. Three more tallies in the seventh and again in the eighth sealed the win. Jordan Jereb pitched the final seven I innings in relief to earn the win and take tournament MVP honors.

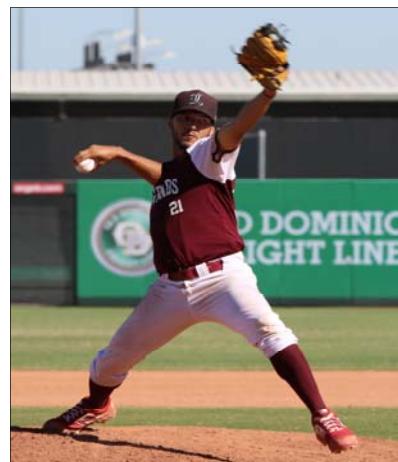
