### MSBL World Series Spotlight DFW Orioles - Antonio Jones

In his own words...

I have been involved with MSBL for 24 years. I started in 1995 in the Memphis MSBL and also played in the Ft. Worth MSBL



from 1997 through 2002 and returned to the Memphis MSBL in 2002. I was a former baseball player at Texas College in Tyler, Tx from 1973 to 1976. I did not like softball and found an adult league in Memphis. I have been attending the MSBL World Series for 13 years and have played in the Fall Classic seven times. I have regularly played in the Billy Townsend Memorial Day Tournament in Atlanta and the Rocket City Classic in Huntsville, AL. The Mid-South Warriors have won each at least five times. Here is a list of some of our championships: 2003 47 National Fall Classic as player/manager with the Mid-South Warriors, 2007 52 National Fall Class as player with the USA Patriots, 2012 52 American Fall Classic as player/ manager with the Mid-South Warriors and 2015 55 Cactus World Series as player/ manager with the Mid-South Warriors I am now retired from Management at the City of Memphis Department of Public Works in 2016 after 17 years. I currently work part time as a driver and auto mechanic. My wife Valerie Jones has been my number one fan and proud supporter and often travels to tournaments with me cheering me on. One of my most significant MSBL moments was winning my first tournament at the 2003 Fall Classic with Gary D'Ambrisi handing me the trophy at Al Lang Stadium. My favorite World Series moment was winning the 55 Cactus in 2015, my first World Series win after eight tries. We were the underdogs but won decisively. Playing in the MSBL has given me purpose outside of working for a living to help support my family. I like the comradery with my team mates and making life-long friends. I find joy in introducing other guys to play in their first tournament then seeing them hooked on returning to Arizona or Florida every year.

New - Player Playoff Eligibility Form Lists Games Played At A Glance Players Need At Least 2 Plate Appearances - Pitchers - 3 Outs And 1 At Bat By Tom Prendergast

In an attempt to help clarify the exemptions a team receives, the National MSBL Office has spelled out the policy and added a new form (that managers can exchange before the game starts), which should certainly help clarify any questions. In addition to this, they have also encouraged team managers to place an asterisk next to the name of the player who received a special exemption. Before the game begins, both teams should be submitting their complete rosters to the other manager. This information should include, first and last names and their jersey number. For our participation divisions, managers determine the number of players that must get at least one plate appearance, before the game starts. For example, if a team only has 13 players at the start of the game, then that number is 13 and the other team can match that number. Any questions regarding player eligibility need to be determined through the WS office. Umpires are not in a position to answer any questions regarding player eligibility issues. A quick call to the MSBL World Series office is the way to proceed on that one.

### MSBL World Series Spotlight Chicago North - Dan Gooris

In his own words...

I have been playing in the Chicago North Men's Senior Baseball League since 1991. I ran into a fellow coach from our local youth baseball program at a convenience



store wearing an Oakland A's uniform. When I asked him if he thought he was Tony La Russa, he told me about this new men's baseball league and asked me if I wanted to play on his team. The rest is history. I have played in every World Series since 1992, and this will be my 27<sup>th</sup> year. I have also played in a couple Las Vegas Kickoff Classics and our own Chicago North sponsored tournaments. We won our first ring in 2009 (55+) with our National Pastime team, followed by rings in 2013 (60+) and 2017 (65+) with our TSP Fire team. I was a Police Officer in a northern suburb of Chicago, retiring in 2006 as their Chief of Police. From there I became the Director of Campus Security at North Park University where I currently work. To keep me busy, I also coached baseball and football at our local high school and coached the college softball team for 18 years. I have been married to Tina, my college sweetheart, for the past 45 years. She has also attended every World Series with me since 1992. My daughter Dana (Ryan) played softball for me on the college team and was a three time All Conference player and was inducted into the North Park University Hall of Fame. She has three boys, two of which are currently playing high school baseball and football, while the third is a gymnast. My son Danny (Hillary) pitched at Creighton University and was drafted

by the Cincinnati Reds and played in the San Diego Padres organization. He has three young daughters and is currently the pitching coach at Libertyville High School. The most significant event in my MSBL career is when we won our first ring in 2009 after 17 tries. We were up by two runs with two outs and two men on in the ninth against the Hollywood Stars. I called time out and walked out to the mound and told George Karas that if he struck out the batter, I would pick him up and carry him off the field. George froze the batter with a curve for the third strike and we won the game. Winning the first ring and watching the faces on "my guys" was priceless. I still have the photo of Mike Weinberg who had also just won his first ring running from the dugout with the biggest grin on his face. I have been blessed to be able to play the game I love and to be able to come out to Arizona for 27 years. I still remember my first year in 1992. I thought I had died and gone to heaven. After losing in the semi-finals in 2008, I asked my good friend and mentor Bart Zeller if he would take over managing our team. Since Bart has joined us, the one constant you will always see when you play a Fire team is that everyone respects the game and plays it the way it should be played. I don't play tennis, I stink at golf, but baseball has been what identifies me. I am a baseball player, and I have been a baseball player since my first game when I was eight years old. When you reflect back, you played with your buddies in Little League for 6-7 years, throw in four years of high school, maybe Senior League or Legion ball in the summer for a couple of years, followed by four years in college and summer semi-pro. But when you start doing the math, I have been playing with the same core group of guys for almost 27 years. We have experienced and shared the same life experiences, the highs and lows, and have one thing is common, we love the game.
