Director of Communications Sacramento MSBL member Jim Tygrett-DeNuzzi served a three-year term as league president from 2009-2012, and at the urging of league brothers, returned to that post in 2013, when his successor stepped down, and remained in a second term thru 2014. That's just one example of Jim's selflessness and is the main reason why he was inducted into the 2013 class of the MSBL National Hall of Fame. Aside from being a top administrator, Tygrett-DeNuzzi is a player who has also been to the MSBL World Series mountain top more than once with the Sacramento Silverbacks, Solons, Tribe, and Royals and was the team's World Series MVP in 2009. MSBL Founder and President Steve Sigler noted Jim's contribution this way: "Jim possesses every quality not only necessitated by an adult baseball league but for any company in need of highly organized, dedicated and experienced leaders." Since then Jim continues to attend the World Series and has picked up additional championships with the Sacramento Royals at the World Series and the Florida Fall Classic. He remains active in league and has been managing the Royals at the World Series the last two years along with teammate and friend Gary Stonebrook. Jim remains a part of the Sacramento MSBL as League Consultant to president and friend

45+ and 60+ Central Teams Must Bat 14 During Pool Play Games

Local Highway Construction Playing Havocs With Normal Drive Times By Tom Prendergast

As the games begin for week 3, just a few reminders about the protocol for this weeks teams. During pool play games all 45+ and 60+ Central and Cactus teams need to get 14 players a plate appearance during scheduled nine inning games. Keep in mind the penalty for not doing this is a forfeit. So with the shared batter position option, this should be a no-brainer. Also team manager's must exchange complete rosters before the game begins and it needs to include, first and last names, jersey number and the players age. In addition all players must have a photo ID for every player, with them at the game. This way in case of any age related questions, the manager can refer to the players driver's license.




