It's always tough enough getting around the greater metropolitan Phoenix area at this time of the year. But when you add to the mix several road construction projects, it just makes it that much more challenging when traveling from one field to another. It's especially aggravating when lane closures complicate these construction projects. So to help you avoid these kind of travel related issues, it's a good idea to check out the Arizona Department of Transportation website and select current "Travel Warnings" for the greater Phoenix metropolitan area. They have a map of the freeways posted on the sight with red warning's on certain highways.

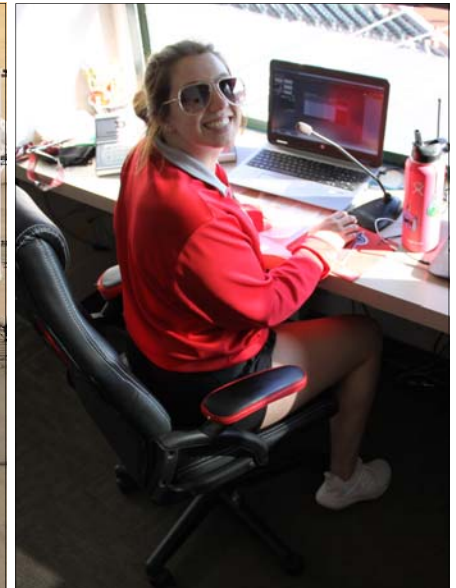
