MSBL World Series Ex Professional Ballplayers Requirements

A player must be out of professional baseball (A, AA, AAA, or Major League) for three complete seasons before becoming eligible to participate in MSBL / MABL National Tournaments. Therefore, for the 2021 World Series and Fall Classic, any player who received compensation and participated with a professional baseball team (A, AA, AAA or Major League) during 2019 or more recently is ineligible unless given special permission to participate by the National Tournament Rules Committee. A player who played in a Rookie League,

A player who played in a Rookie League, Independent League or who was invited to a Major League Spring Training and then released without playing for a minor league affiliate will not be held to the requirements listed above, except for Central Division and Cactus Division.

If a particular player played in any kind of "Foreign Professional League" in Japan, Mexico, Puerto Rico or Venezuela, and was paid to play, then that player must be out a minimum of 3 complete seasons (2018 and prior) to participate.

These players will be eligible to participate in the Central Division if out a minimum of 20 years. These players will not be eligible to participate in Cactus or Desert divisions unless they have been out for 30 years.

All other foreign professional leagues are not recognized when determining ex-pro status. For all Central Divisions - If a player has played pro ball (with the exception of Major Leagues) and has been out of pro ball for 20 years, this player is eligible to play in the Central Division.

Ex-Pros are limited to 2 per team with no restrictions to position or limitation to round robin, playoff or Championship appearance. In reference to players who played Rookie or Independent League baseball only, these players are ineligible unless they are out 20 years for Central. (continued on page 3)

Exchanging Team Rosters Before Every \bar{G} ame Is A Manager's Responsibility By Tom Prendergast

One of the new rule changes we adopted this year was to require every team manager to provide his opponent with a complete list of his players, including first and last names, their jersey number, age and if they ever played baseball as a professional. The thinking was that by doing this we would reduce the chances of a team protesting another teams, alleged illegal player or players. And if this took place before the game started then we wouldn't have any of those "gotcha protests" where a team would play that card late in a game they were going to lose. It's really a simple concept. Bring an extra team roster to every game and make sure the other teams manager receives it. If a teams got no issues, then it no big deal.

Speaking of protests, batting out of turn isn't on the list of protestable offenses. Add to that list the wrong jersey number, or a misspelled last name (that's a clerical error). The MSBL provides an official scorebook for every tournament that we host. Inside the front cover you will find the phone numbers for calling in scores or reporting problems. Also inside are the printed tournament rules and regulations. Seems like this might be a good place to start before handing that \$50 bill to the home plate umpire regarding a possible protest. Statistically speaking, a teams chances of actually winning a protest are somewhat slim. On occasion a team will prevail (and when that happens they get their money back) and a decision will be overturned. MSBL games are won and lost on the field, not in the WS office.

Playoff seeding is another hot topic that can be confusing at times. Teams who allow the fewest runs usually prevail if it comes down to a wildcard spot. Our first tie breaker is head to head competition, but only with teams in your division. Wildcards are based on fewest runs!


