MSBL National Hall of Fame Inductee: Don Etheridge, W Metro Atlanta MSBL

nearby Smyrna, Georgia. For his many years of dedication and leadership, MSBL Founder and President Steve Sigler has inducted Don into the 2021 class of the MSBL National Hall of Fame.

"I was shocked when Steve Sigler called and told me, and I am not sure I have yet to fully absorb it. Knowing that there are a lot of people who put a lot of time and dedication into making MSBL what it is, I consider it a real honor to have been selected for this award. I am both humbled and honored to be selected for this award."

We asked Don where his baseball roots began and how it wound around to Atlanta. "I started playing in the Greater Atlanta MSBL in 1996 and served as President in 2000-2001," explained Etheridge. "I founded the WMAMSBL in 2005 and the league is currently being headed up by 2015 MSBL Honor Roll member Ron Huck.

Our Midweek league has seven teams and Saturday totals 10. Our season starts in early April, with playoffs concluding the week before Labor Day. I am just glad we have a robust MSBL program here in Atlanta. I love the comments from players saying that they are glad to be able to continue to play the game we all love." Added Don, "One of the most satisfying aspects of our league is having started it from scratch and watching it grow and of course seeing new players coming into the league and watching seniors continuing to play the game they love. We also send many players and teams to the MSBL national tournaments, which is equally satisfying. It is also very satisfying to see our friends bringing in their friends to play. There are continually new friends being made by our league members

18+ Teams Start Games As The Last Division To Play This Year

Fewest Runs Allowed Category Crucial To A Bubble Teams Chances of Advancing By Tom Prendergast

Chances are teams with the fewest runs allowed will advance to the playoffs, if there in a division with several teams that have the same record. Our rules stipulate that when two or more teams finish with the same record, the first tie breaker will be based on head to head competition. However, if team A beats team B, and team B beats team C and team C beats team A, we've got a stalemate. Our solution, fewest runs allowed. Same kind of logic applies to the wildcard teams. OK so what happens when two teams who didn't play each other also end up allowing the same number of runs? Well that's happened before and our next seldom used tie breaker would be best run differential. And if we are still tied after that the two teams would arrive an hour early and play a 3 inning tie breaking game.

While the MSBL National website (Pointstreak) shows the game results and the division standings and team stats, it doesn't always sort the teams correctly. The official standings can be found in the Daily News (which can be found in the pro shop or online) and in our office at Tempe Diablo Stadium. And depending on how the playoffs are structured in a division, some teams with a better record (then the team they are playing) could end up as the wildcard. So every team manager should be checking their runs allowed that are posted to verify they are correct. It's not unusual for the WS office to get three different scores for the same game.

CENTRAL, CACTUS & DESERT Divisions - Minimum of one plate appearance per game for at least 14 dressed players. In regards to the playoffs, teams have an option of only batting 10 batters for all playoff round and will not need to get 14 players at least one plate appearance - except for 55+/60+/65+/70+ divisions.






