Bob Korvas: Thirty-Five Year World Series Attendee

Coming home from school about 3:15 each day, I caught the end of the Chicago Cubs (day games only then) on WGN. That eventually paved the way to a full ride at Northeastern Illinois University where a 1975 injury ended my potential pro baseball aspirations. I had not touched a 9 inch baseball again until my wife Kathy sent me to a Cubs Fantasy Camp 1988 where I met Mike Pinto (original Chicago North MSBL league president) and Dr. Preston Wolin. "When A Win Isn't Always A Win"- (Scorebook Due Diligence Matters) MSBL WS Office Receives A Couple Hundred Text Messages Every Day By Tom Prendergast

In the early days of the MSBL WS tournament, every team called in their score after the game and you would get to speak with a real person. In our 35th year, teams are still using the phone to report their scores, except there's no talking - just texting. For most games we receive 3 scores. One from the home team, one from the visiting team and one from the umpires. And about 20% of the time they all match. But it's pretty unusual to get a different score where both teams think they won or tied. When that happens, we call both teams and speak with the managers. If we still can't resolve it we will call the umpires. When all else fails, we ask that both teams bring a copy of their scorebook to the WS office, so we can review it and retrace the progress of the game. That's one reason we still require teams to use a scorebook, if something like this occurs. In this case, both teams had easy to read, very well documented, detailed scoring. The problem was that one book showed a runner left on base at third, while the other showed him scoring. End result, the home team book prevailed and the game was recorded as a tie. This doesn't happen very often, maybe once every 1000 games.

Note - Crossover Games against National teams in the pool play round update.

in Arizona created by some guy named
Sigler from New York. This story isn't about
35 consecutive years playing in Arizona. It's
about where MSBL and baseball has brought
me to. Finding the MSBL World Series
placed opportunities, experiences and
memories I would never have had if I not
said 'yes' to Mike Pinto. At the time I was
only playing 16in 'Chicago style' (no glove)
slow pitch softball. While not exactly baseball, the game I grew up on as a kid and had
a deep passion for satisfied my need to play
and compete.

In my first ever MSBL World Series game we were at Grand Canyon College. Our Chicago North Cubs were playing against the Hollywood Stars. We only had 13 guys, with five guys that pitched, to cover six games over four days.

I first read about Steve Sigler and MSBL in Sports Illustrated and we eventually met and became friends. Steve invited me to play (be his catcher) on the first MSBL team USA friendship series in St Thomas VI ('91,'92). I had the pleasure of meeting his entire, wonderful family. I pitched a complete nine inning game which we won and I also hit three home runs at the downtown soccer /baseball stadium, which included a 420 foot center field fence with a huge mahogany tree 'inside' on the field of all things. It was broadcast on 'national St. Thomas VI radio' and I was interviewed postgame as the player of the game, which was a thrill.

Championships are just one part of being there each year. Over 35 years at the MSBL World Series I've been in the playoffs about 80% of the years, a Championship game over half, and won multiple rings.

I've caught a seven inning no hitter at Autry field for teammate (continued on page 4)




