Spotlight On - Dan Gooris 70+ Chicago North TSP Fire

The Chicago Fire in an institution. No, not
the one started in the O'Leary barn in 1871.
This one is full of history and definitely winners. I have been playing against, and occasionally for, these guys and you always
know it is going to be a struggle to get past
them. Dan Gooris is the current leader of the
pack with the Fire, now known as Chicago
North TSP Fire, as they will be competing
in the 70-over Central division this year,
where they won yet another ring last year.

We were able to corner Dan Gooris and ask him a little about the history of the Fire and how things began.

"I personally started going to Arizona in 1992 and my World Series career began with the Chicago North Cubs," said Dan. "Back then Bart Zeller was in charge of the Fire and they always played in the top divisions and always fielded a team that the Chicago entries looked up to because of their pattern of successes." I asked Dan when he took the reins from Bart, which seems like it was just recently but I was surprised to hear it was 15 years ago!

"I had been toiling with the Cubs until 2008 and never won a ring. We even changed our name once to the Red Dogs but we didn't scare anyone with that move and met the same fate. Then in 2008 Bart and his exceptional player and close friend, George Karras, were watching one of my games and they asked me after the game if I would like to become a player/coach with them. Bart wanted to back off a little, though he is still an invaluable coach and advisor to this day and remains on the team." I have noticed that throughout the years the Fire has gone through a few name changes. "When I took on my new role, we became 'Windy City' but after a couple of years we came back around to the 'Fire.' TSP is the name of a sports apparel company run by our league president Max Reising and his partner Bruce Zimmerman. Bruce was a long-time player for the Fire and just recently decided to hang them up. They have kept us in uniforms! Having a baseball mind like Bart on board as a mentor has been invaluable. New Government Issued Photo ID Rule Requires Players To Have One National MSBL Office Was Compelled To Take This Step Due to Past Incidents By Tom Prendergast

Last year a team manager called the WS office, wanting to check on an opposing player's eligibility to participate in the tournament. No problem - I asked the other teams manager to text me a copy of his driver's license and he did so within 5 minutes. The driver's license name matched what was on the teams roster. End of story, crisis solved - but it wasn't. Turns out that the manager who requested the player's ID, didn't think it was the same guy who was playing in the game. Of course this was a playoff game and the losing manager lodged an official protest, stating that the player in question, wasn't actually the guy on the roster and in fact he was a former major league player.

OK fair enough, I told the winning manager that I would be at the team's semi-final game in the morning and conduct an ID check, myself. Several hours later, the manager called me back to inform me that the player in question had to return home - due to a family emergency. Well needless to say, this wasn't good for anybody. And quite frankly, it didn't pass the smell test. So I dropped the ball on that one! This wasn't the first time that something like this came up. Over the years many players had been summoned to the WS office, only to inform me that they didn't bring their ID with them to Arizona, because they drove with a friend. Kind a made me wonder if you still have to show an ID to get into the strip clubs around town? Well at least they did when I was a player (or so I was told). Bottom line, even the players who had a fake ID at least gave it the old college try.

So starting this year the National Office mandated that every player participating in the WS tournament needed to have a government issued ID (with a photo), with them during games. This way, any kind of player ID issue could be resolved right at the *(continued on page 3)*

field. If for some reason, the player didn't have an ID, then he has to come out of the game immediately and then has an hour, to return with his government issued ID - or the team forfeits the game. In addition, any other games that this player played in would also be forfeited.

On the surface, it seems like this would not only make sense, but nip this issue in the bud. I would anticipate that if one team is going to request an ID check, the other manager will be wanting to see his player's ID's as well. Bottom line, if a player doesn't have a government issued ID - he can't play. Now, in the event that a player is driving on a suspended license, then a passport or military issued card will suffice. Or a state issued ID card will also work. Sadly, your Costco card won't cut it. At the end of the day, this protocol will certainly help resolve most issues that might involve a suspected illegal player.

Playoff Eligibility Form -

Every team that qualifies for the playoffs, needs to complete the Playoff Eligibility Form (before the team can play in any playoff / semi-final or championship games).

Approximately 30 minutes before the home plate meeting, team managers should exchange their lineup sheets and the playoff eligibility form. If a team manager doesn't have the form completed prior to the home plate meeting, the game will be allowed to start on time, which will give the manager time to prepare the form and submit it to the opposing manager, before the end of the second inning. If the manager is unable to provide this form before the third inning begins, the game will be declared a 9-0 forfeit win.

I feel that this is a contributing factor to the success of the Fire these past 30 years." **Dan** is a catcher by trade but like many of us continuing to grind away in the 70+ division, it has become hard to throw on the gear and get behind the plate very often. "I have now evolved into having a first baseman's legs," chuckled Gooris. One of his favorite moments as the Chicago manager, was winning the final in 2009. I have a picture where "I'm the catcher and George Karas is in my arms after striking out the Hollywood Stars batter for our first World Series Championship in 2009. A couple of my teammates experienced some bad luck right after we won. John Engeriser, spent months in the ICU after contracting Legionnaires Disease in the Phoenix hotel he was staying in. And **Mike** Weinberg, fell down a flight of stairs (the year before and broke his arm) just days before the start of the World Series.

I had to ask Dan what his plans were for the future and if there were any immediate goals. "At our age, there are no real goals except to continue playing this great game as long as we can, reconnect with friends, stay healthy, and if a ring happens, it happens. The only goal I can control is making sure we continue carrying on the great **Windy City** and **Fire** tradition. We will always be respectful of the game and our opponents and at the end of the day, all will be good."
