Valley Of The Sun Heat Wave Continues As MSBL WS Players Battle the Heat Soaring Temperature Reaches the Century Mark As Playoffs Begin

The warmer than usual temperatures continue this week as the 90's gave way to a triple digit number yesterday - 102 degrees! And as hot as it was on a grass infield the turf at Legacy Park was probably 20 degrees hotter than that. This was pretty intense, especially for the players who aren't accustomed to this kind of heat. It was searing and miserable. Guys were going through lots of water and sports drinks.

Needless to say it was imperative to stay hydrated, especially in this weather. All of the TV weather people have pointed to Sunday as the last day of this current heat spell. Let's hope they are right!

A couple of 25+ Central managers were disappointed yesterday when they found out the normal rule that requires teams to get 14 players an at bat during a 9 inning game, has been waived for the division this year. That's because the Mountain and Central divisions were combined into one, for this year. And just a reminder, teams can't protest a win. A team that lodges a protest is requesting the WS staff right a



wrong, that caused their team to lose a game, due to some rule violation. Lodging a protest to get a better score, say 9-0 instead of 15-14 isn't allowed. Speaking of protests, we don't accept a third party protest. For example, team A is playing team B, and loses the game. A manager from team C, noticed a discrepancy in the team B lineup and then notified the office, that they were submitting the protest on behalf of team A. So that won't fly either. Yesterday a team manager, after a loss, called the office and wanted to protest a player from the winning team who had a similar name of a former MLB player. After a prolonged attempt to get a driver's license, it turned out to be a different guy. Better to do this in person, at the field.

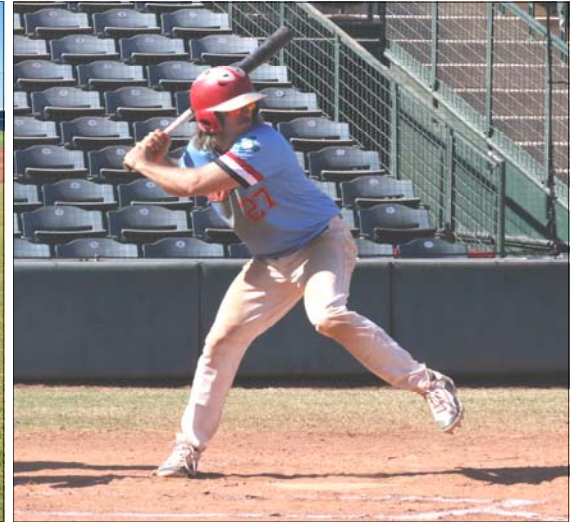
